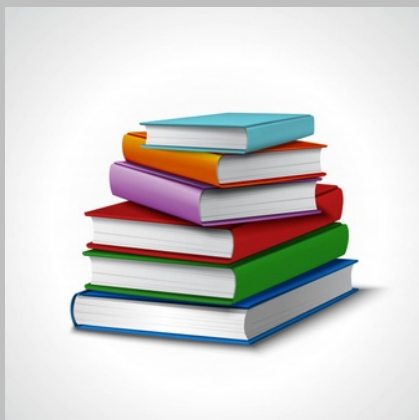

Back to Human: How Great Leaders Create Connection in the Age of Isolation, by Dan

Schawbel. *Back to Human* explains how a more socially connected workforce creates greater fulfillment, productivity, and engagement while preventing burnout and turnover. The next generation of leaders must create a workplace where teammates feel genuinely connected, engaged, and empowered—without relying on technology. Dan Schawbel reveals why virtual communication, though vital and useful, actually contributes to a stronger sense of isolation at work than ever before. He offers a self-assessment called the “Work Connectivity index” that measures the strength of team relationships, and shares exercises, examples, and activities that readers can work on individually or as a team, which will help them increase personal productivity, be more collaborative, and become more fulfilled at work.
